- Have a full-time counselor.


 Provide extended day instruction for kindergarten and allday kindergarten for English Language Development.



The overall state rating is intended to summarize this school's particular successes and challenges. It is based on a combination of up to five factors. Level 1 = Falls into the bottom 5% of schools


Level 2 = Falls between 5% and 15% of schools
